16-year old, Ashley Fulton is an award-winning singer, songwriter, producer and pianist. At age 7, she took to the stage developing her voice by playing many leading roles, including Maria in The Sound of Music and Glinda in The Wizard of Oz.

Ashley started producing music at the age of 11, using LogicPro as her preferred production software. Ashley produces, writes and sings across multiple genres.

Ashley's musical training consists of classical piano at The Music Settlement and The Celebrity School of Music; voice training at The Helen Todd Voice Studio; and songwriting training at the 2016 summer songwriting workshop at Berklee College of Music in Boston and the 2017 summer songwriting workshop at New York University's music school in New York City. Ashley is also very active in the music program at Hawken School.

In 2016, Ashley was the grand prize winner of the Delta Sigma Theta Jabberwock Scholarship talent competition. In 2017, Ashley was awarded the Gold medal for both the Cleveland and the National NAACP ACT-SO awards for music composition. Ashley's original song "Carry Me" was awarded Best Song of the Month (August 2017) by SongwriterUniverse.com, and she was 1 of 4 scholarship winners in the 2017 Shining Star Singing Competition.
